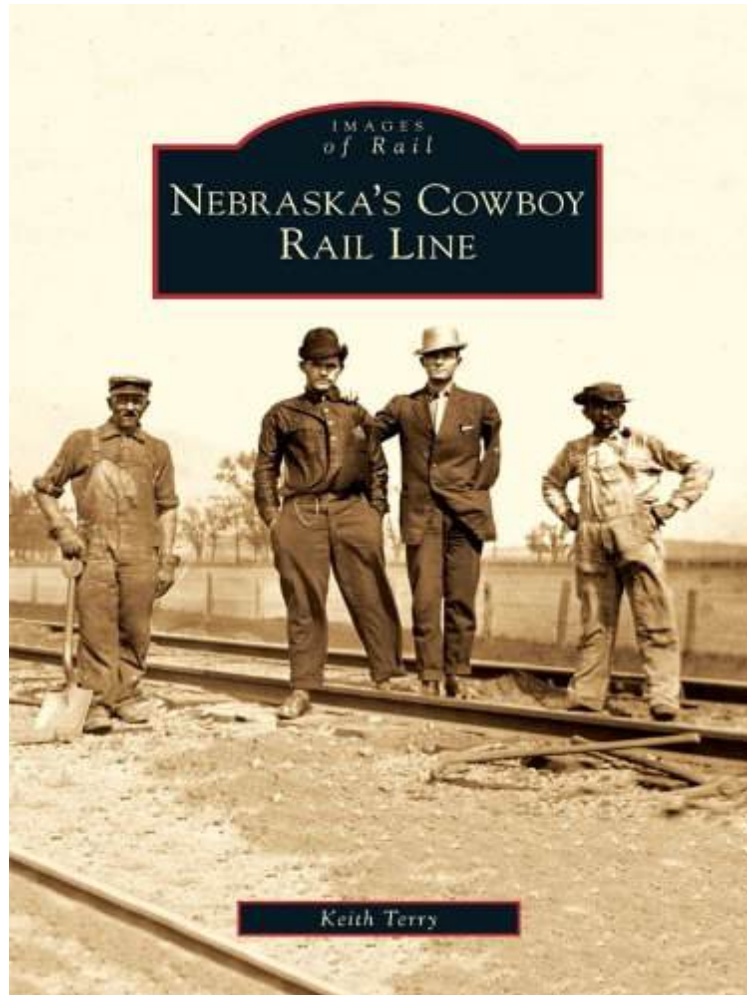

started in 1869 was the impetus for the establishment of many towns and even the relocation of some along the route. The line was employed to transport miners to the Black Hills during the gold rush of the late 1800s; it carried thousands of Irish and German immigrants to the largely unpopulated West.
